## **Transportation**

The FCPS Transportation page contains helpful information regarding policies for walking, biking, and taking the bus to school. FCPS provides a tool for parents and students, Here Comes the Bus app. This app allows you to track your bus in real time. For transportation concerns, please call 703-466-2050. If after 5:30pm, please call School Security at 571-423-2000.

Students who ride the **bus** should only ride their assigned bus. Riding the bus is a privilege, and acceptable standards of conduct are expected of all bus passengers. **Kindergarten students** who ride the bus in the afternoon are to be met at the bus door and asked for by name by a parent, parent designee, guardian, or a responsible middle school age or higher sibling. Children will be returned to school if not met.

**Kiss and Ride** is in the lower parking lot. The front loop is reserved for bus traffic and emergency vehicles only. Students should stay in the car until a school staff member opens the car door, starting at 8:15am. Dismissal begins at 3:15pm.

# **Reporting Absences or Late Arrivals**

If your child is going to be absent for the entire day, or late for any reason, please either call the school attendance line at **703-503-3535** before 9:00am, complete our <u>online attendance form</u>, or email the attendance office at <u>littlerun@fcps.edu</u>. If the school does not receive notification from the parent, the absence will be unexcused.

If your child will be absent for an extended period, more than 4 days, please fill out a <u>Prearranged</u> <u>Absence form</u> and email it to <u>littlerun@fcps.edu</u> or bring it into the office.

## Change in Dismissal/Early Dismissal

Please complete the <u>Change in Dismissal/ Early Dismissal form</u> to request a change in dismissal routine. All online requests should be made by 12:00pm For any changes or emergencies after 12:00pm, please contact the office at 703-503-3500. Form response will be forwarded to the classroom teacher indicated. If you have multiple Little Run ES students for whom this change applies, you must complete this form for each child.

When a student is going home with another student, it is expected that parents coordinate plans beforehand. Each family must submit the online form by 12:00pm.

#### Little Run Health Room

Our Health Room is staffed by the Fairfax County Health Department. The School Health Aides who staff the Health Room are NOT nurses, but are trained by the Health Department and work under the supervision of a Public Health Nurse. If your child becomes sick or has an injury, you will be contacted. If it is determined your child needs to go home, please pick up your child as soon as possible. The emergency contact persons listed on your child's Emergency Care form may be contacted to pick up your child if you cannot be reached. Please review this handy When to Keep My Child Home information sheet.

#### **Medication**

If your child needs to take prescription or over-the-counter medications during the school day, it is necessary for the parent/guardian (and in some cases, a doctor) to complete authorization forms. Forms and more information are available on our Health Room page.

Parents must transport medications to and from school. Please do not send medication in a student's backpack. All medications must be kept in the clinic and taken under adult supervision.

#### Cafeteria

\*Payments can be made via MySchoolBucks, cash, or check to cafeteria manager.

MySchoolBucks- This online payment service provides a quick and easy way to pay for school related purchases. You will be able to pay for a variety of school fees using credit/debit cards or electronic checks. Once the account is open, parents can check the fund account at any time.

# **Birthday Treats**

Due to a variety of reasons, students may not bring treats (food or non-food) in to school to celebrate birthdays. Birthdays will be recognized in the classroom in a special way (morning message, crowns, extra recess, pencil/card, etc.). Teachers will communicate how they celebrate birthdays in their classroom at Back to School night. Please DO NOT send in treats as they will be returned home an in effort to keep our school safe

## **ParentVUE**

Parents can access their child(ren)s academic records and course information through ParentVUE. Please contact our registrar, Victoria Reyes, to request a ParentVUE Activation Code. Once you have created your account, you can log into ParentVUE.

### Schoology

Your ParentVUE account allows you to access <u>Schoology</u> to keep track of student assignments and due dates. You will use the same username and password as your ParentVUE account.

# Emergency Care Form & weCare@school

Please keep the office informed of any changes in home, work, or emergency contact information. Please contact the school by emailing <u>littlerun@fcps.edu</u> or come in person to update your child's information. We cannot make changes over the phone. You can also update your child's emergency care information by logging into <u>ParentVUE</u> and selecting weCare@school in the FCPS Links button.

# Registration, Transfers, and Student Records

If you are moving, please fill out a <u>Student</u> <u>Withdrawal form</u> and email it to <u>Victoria Reyes</u> or bring it into the office at least one week prior to the child's transfer or withdrawal date. Our registrar, Victoria Reyes, will contact you upon receipt of form.

If you are interested in transferring your child to another FCPS school, and you qualify for one of the <u>transfer types</u>, please email <u>Victoria Reyes</u> or come into the office and she will provide you with additional information.

I you would like a copy of information in your child's cumulative file, i.e. progress reports, immunization records, please email <u>Victoria Reyes</u> or come into the office. She will attempt to comply with your requests within five working days of the date the request was received.

## "Go Paperless"

To receive only online progress reports, log into <u>ParentVUE</u>, then go to My Account and select Go Paperless. To prevent the mailing of printed progress reports, all parents/guardians who live with the student and share the same address must have a ParentVUE account and select the paperless option.
